- ☐ 1. Catalogs, letters, brochures, reports, and similar printed materials, except administrative supplies, the envelopes, containers, and labels used for packaging and mailing same, and paper furnished to a printer for fabrication into such printed materials, when stored for 12 months or less in the Commonwealth and distributed for use outside the Commonwealth. Items purchased must meet all these conditions to qualify for exemption. Exemption also applies to purchases of these items by any advertising businesses which meet all these conditions.
- ☐ 2. Tangible personal property delivered by seller in the seller's vehicle, by a common carrier, by a licensed contract carrier, or by an independent trucker hired by the seller to a factor or export agent for subsequent export to a foreign country.
- ☐ 3. Advertising supplements and other printed matter distributed with or as part of a publication issued daily, or regularly at average intervals not exceeding 3 months. Exemption also applies to purchases of these items by advertising businesses.
- ☐ 4. Advertising which is placed in newspapers, magazines, billboards, broadcasting and other media, including, without limitation, the providing of concept, writing, graphic design, mechanical art, photography and production supervision.
